In early 2025, the "Cedar at 60" campaign reached its \$2 million goal! Construction costs, however, have risen dramatically since the start of our campaign. After final design and bidding in August 2025, we now face a \$1.4 million shortfall to complete the full scope of **renovation**. The board is committed to starting construction so Cedar is ready for summer 2026, and is now launching a second phase of the campaign to cover the shortfall.

The remodeled kitchen will be larger; replacing old equipment (at left) will improve food preparation and energy efficiency.




The lower level bathrooms (at left) used by summer staff will get new showers, and an efficient HVAC system will address longtime moisture issues.
