Quilt donations this year: Shepherd of the Hills Ministries

A long-standing tradition of Ewalu's Quilt Auction is the opportunity to donate quilts to Lutheran-affiliated ministries that serve others. This year, bidders can purchase a quilt and donate it immediately to **Shepherd of the Hills**

(SOTH) Ministries, a non-profit in Saint Olaf, Iowa, that helps those in need in and around Clayton County.

SOTH assists those struggling with housing, domestic situations, fostering, natural disasters, aftermath of a fire, medical challenges and more, and gives assistance for utility bills and rent. The SOTH thrift store at 100 W. Hill St., Saint Olaf, is open to the public M–F, 9 a.m.- noon and 1–4 p.m.

If a crisis family is in need of anything, they get to shop in the store for free and can get 5 items per person in the family each month. Helping children is a huge focus for SOTH, serving hundreds of kids with Back to School backpacks full of supplies, Coats for Kids and Christmas for Kids. SOTH runs on donations only. - Due to the rainy weather forecast, **we're moving the Live Auction inside the newly renovated Cedar Lodge!** We so glad to have the option of using this beautiful, expanded facility. THANK YOU, donors, for helping us "cross the finish line" recently on this important project. Now we get to enjoy it!
- During the auction, if you wish to **donate a quilt to Shepherd of the Hills Ministries**, let the auctioneers know immediately following the sale of the item. Just say, "Send it to Shepherd of the Hills!" (Details on page 7.) We'll take care of getting it there!
- The **Auction Checkout** will be located in the Cedar Lodge entryway; your totals will be recorded throughout the auction and can be settled there immediately after the auction ends. If you are departing early, clerks and recorders may need additional time to process auction sales.
- **"Buyer's Choice" items** have been added throughout the auction this year and will be brought up together for bids. The winning bidder gets to pick which item they want. We're trying this with more items each year to have some fun and make the auction move faster.
- Vote for the Live Auction **People's Choice Award** using the green ballot. Votes must be turned in at the registration table box by 12:30 p.m. The Top 3 items will be brought up for bids together as "Buyer's Choice" during the Live Auction. The winning bidder gets to pick which item they want!
- Over 120 quilts and items will be auctioned off today. An additional 150+ quilts and items are on the **Online Auction website at <https://Auctria.Events/EwaluQuiltAuction>**. 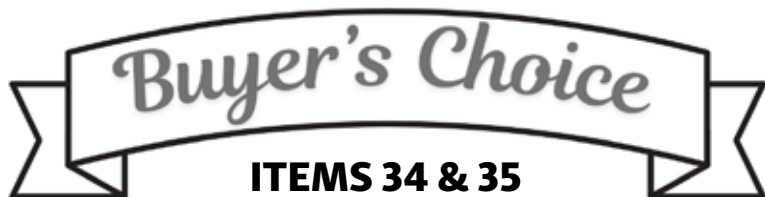

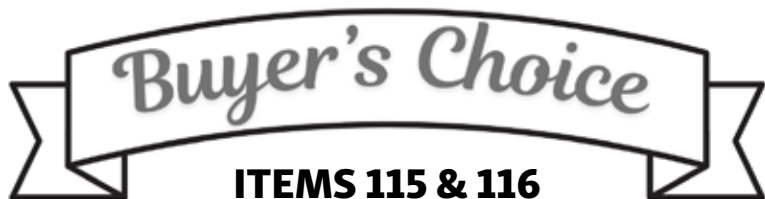
